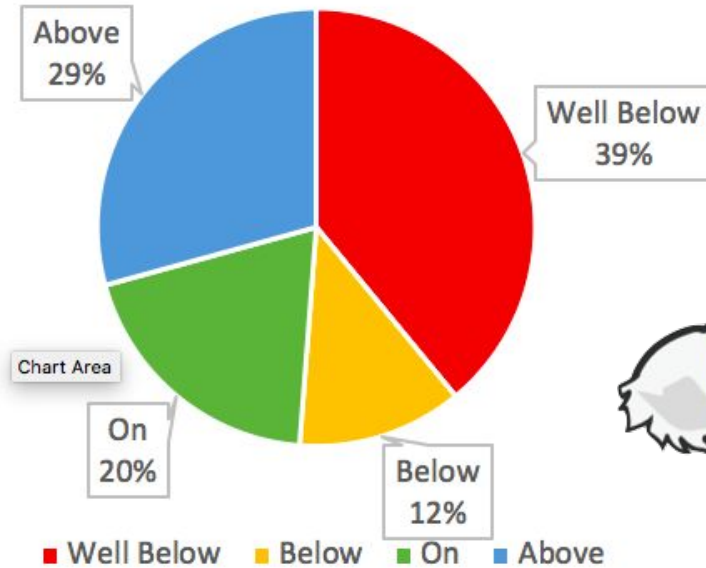

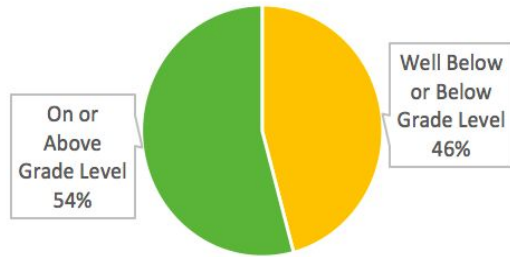

Kindergarten Reading Composite Winter 2021-2022

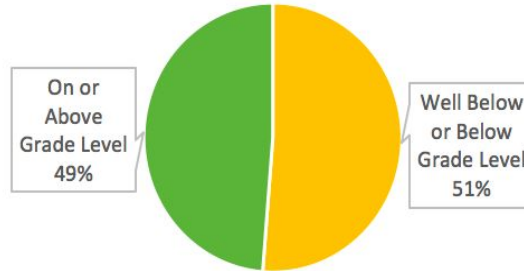

Winter 2019-2020



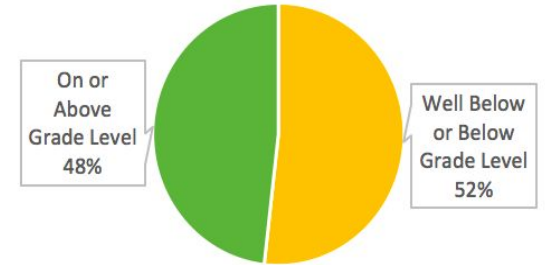

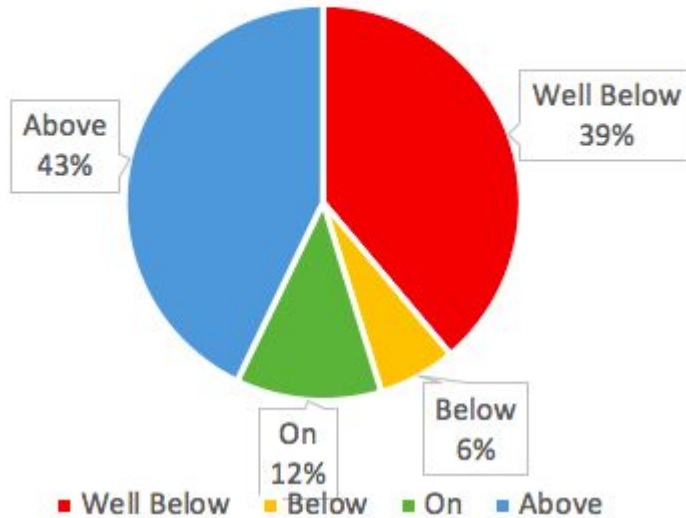

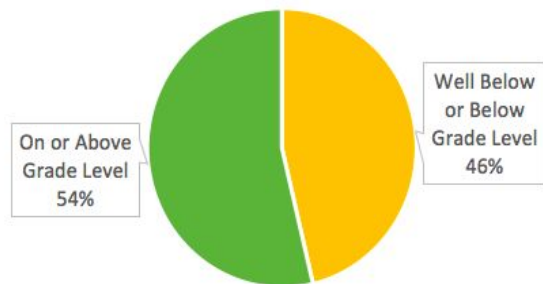

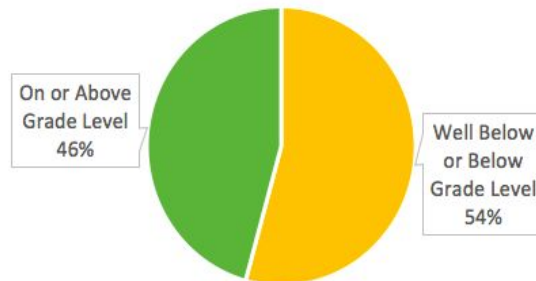

Winter 2021-2022



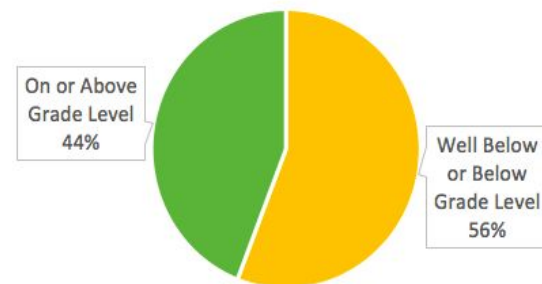

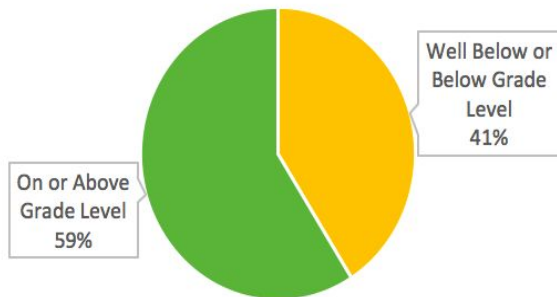
3rd Grade Reading Composite Winter 2021-2022



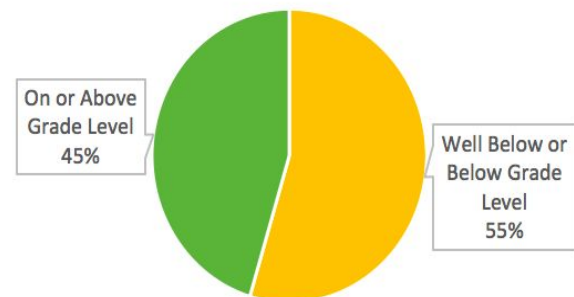
3rd Grade Reading Composite Winter 2019-2020

Winter 2019-2020



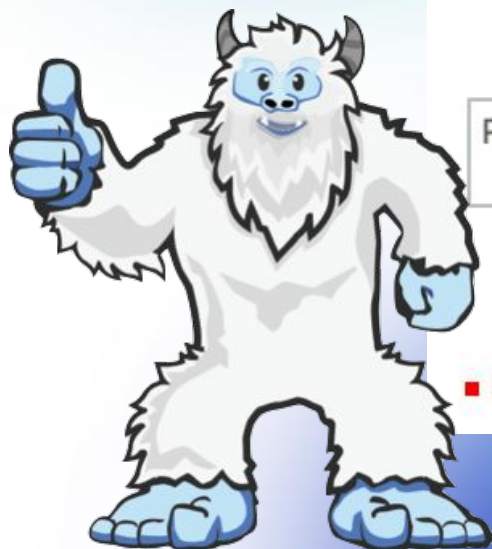
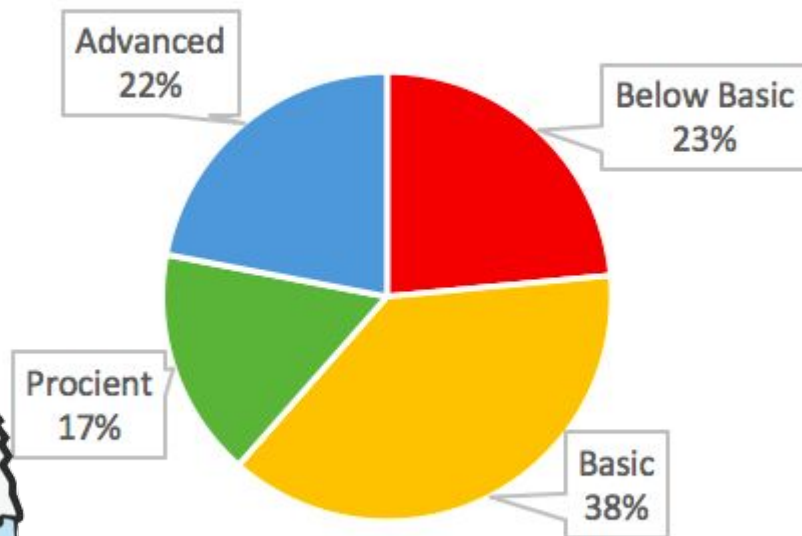

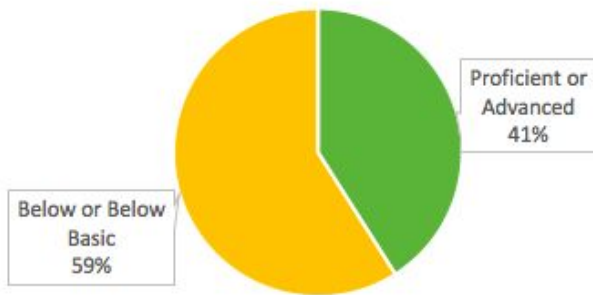

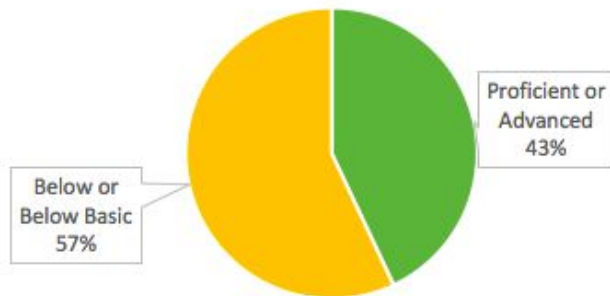

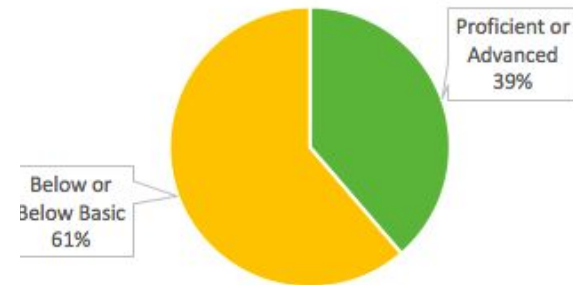

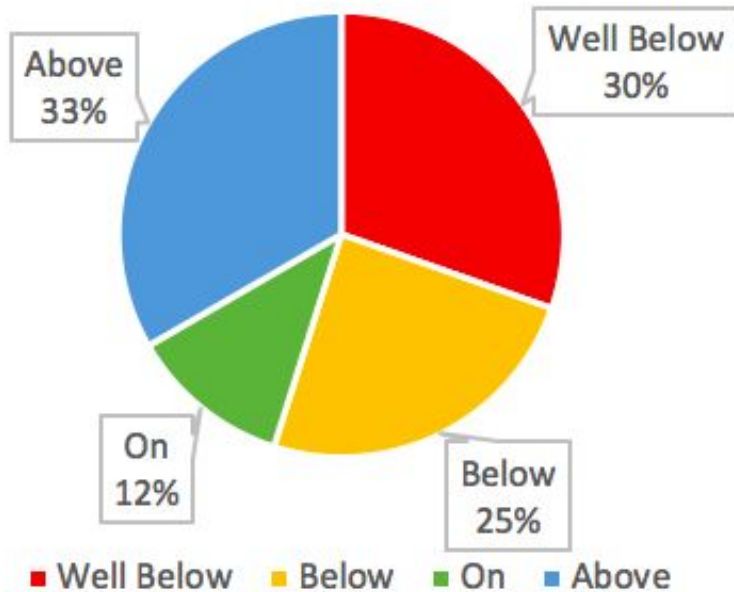


Kindergarten Math Composite Winter 2021-2022

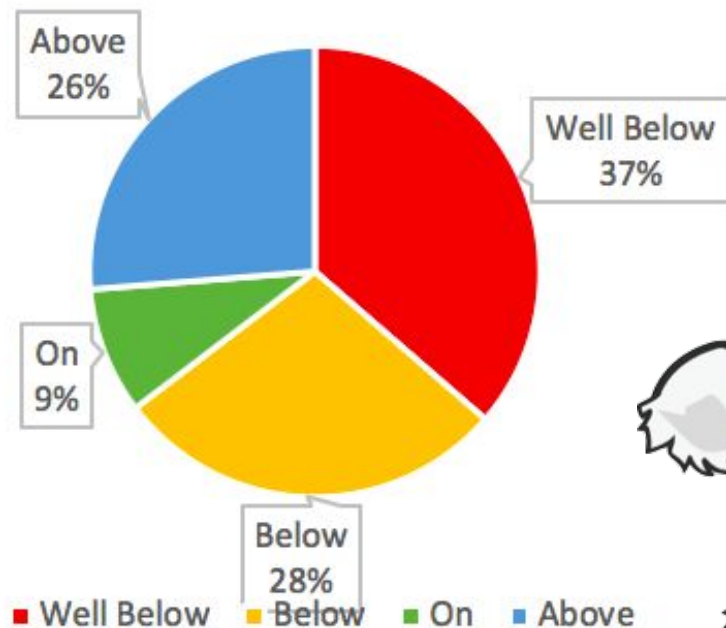




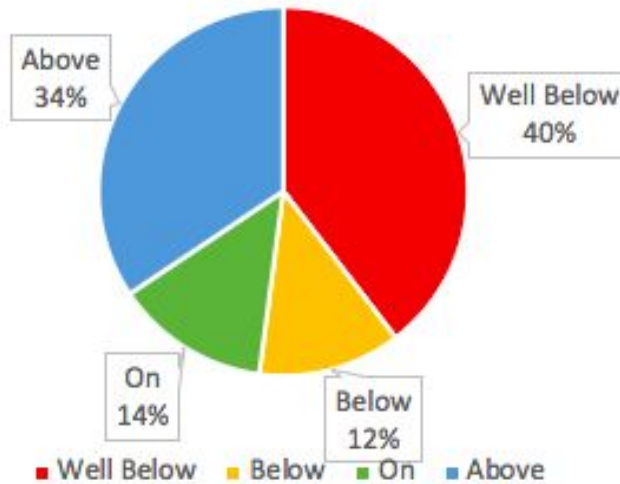
1st Grade Math Composite Winter 2021-2022



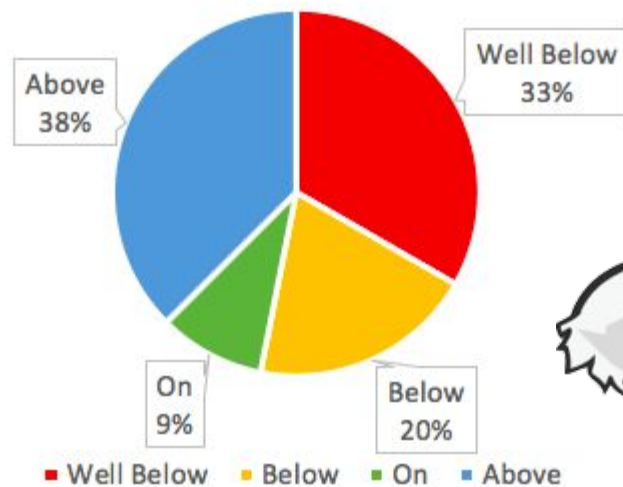
2nd Grade Math Composite Winter 2021-2022



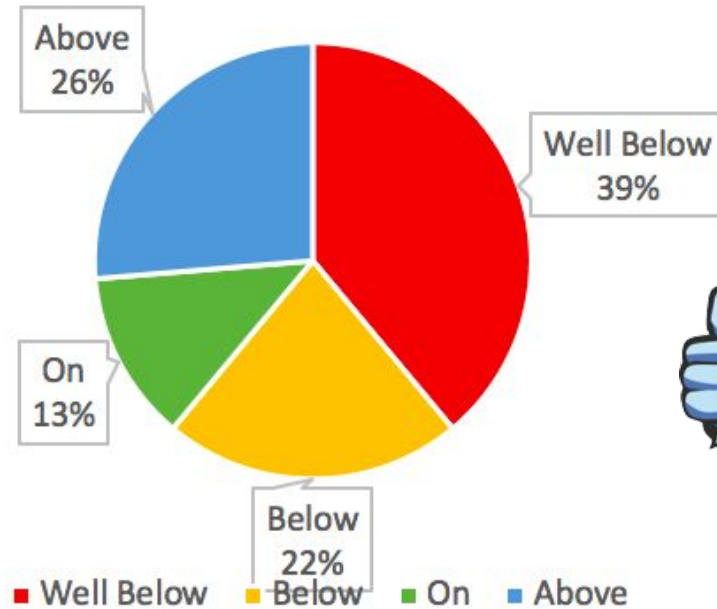
3rd Grade Math Composite Winter 2021-2022

Current LANDTrust plans

Edgemont :

By May of 2022 teachers will demonstrate mastery with cohesive planning through IPLCs for Tier One English Language block to have 80% of students, kindergarten through 5th grade, achieve typical, above typical or well above typical growth in reading as measured by the Spring ELA Acadience Pathways of Progress assessment

Bell View:

75% of K-3 students will make Typical Progress or better on Acadience Reading Composite, & 75% of 4 & 5 students on track for expected growth on RI Fall to Spring

School Climate

Bell View: 100 % of students will receive Zones of Regulation instruction and participate in Morning Meetings daily in every classroom.

Edgemont: By May of 2022, less than 20% of Edgemont students will exhibit moderate to high risk of internalizing and externalizing behaviors as measured by the Spring SSRS-IE data.

Safe Routes Walking plan

Edgemont Suggested Walking Routes:

The attached map shows suggested walking routes for Edgemont Elementary Students.

Arrows shown indicate suggested walking routes. Please select the best route from your home to the school for our students to follow. Mark this route with a red pencil or crayon.

You and your child should become familiar with the route by walking it together. Please instruct your child to follow all crossing guards instructions and to use marked crosswalks.

Please note the following:

1. Students must use sidewalks and/or painted walking areas.
2. Students living in the Peach Blossom sub-division North of 9400 So. will be provided with transportation to/from school on a bus. Because there is not a safe walking path, these students are discouraged from walking to and from school.
3. Students living Northeast of Quarry Bend Dr. will be provided transportation to and from school on a bus. These students are discouraged from walking to and from school because there is not a safe walking path.
4. Students in the Serpentine Way area need to use crosswalks at Forget-Me-Not Avenue, Hosta Lane, Antimony Lane, and Dolomite Lane.
5. Students East of Flint Drive should use crosswalks at Galena Drive, Flint Drive, and Kennelly Avenue.
6. Please refer to the parking lot map for information regarding dropping off and picking up students in front of the school.
7. The buses will use the designated areas in front of the school that are accessible from Galena Drive. Parents wishing to pick up and drop off students should enter the school grounds from Galena Drive.

At Sego Lily Drive, students will cross Sego Lily Drive with the adult crossing guard and continue to school and cross Galena Drive with another adult crossing guard.
